2. Approve the May 11th, 2022 Meeting Summary – Brian Nowotny moved for approval; Travis Hoover seconded. No objections and summary was approved.

3. Approve KCMO – Lexington Gladstone Bikeways Scope Change – Bailey Waters

- a. Scope change is on stretch of Lexington Ave between Garfield and Olive St.
- b. The original scope included a cycle track on the north with two lanes of traffic and parking on the south side.
- c. Proposed a shared street with curb extensions and bump-outs at intersections
 - i. Per neighborhood request for more of a downtown feel with parking on both sides of the street.
- d. Bryant DeLong moved for approval; Wendy Shay seconded. No objections or questions and scope change was approved.

4. Status of Current Program:

a. Program Balances/Updates – Allison Smith, Marisela Ward

- i. KDOT- \$1.1M balance likely to carry into next year with three projects pending obligations. CMAQ is overprogrammed by about \$83,000 and all projects are obligated.
- ii. MoDOT- \$10.5M balance for TAP funds with one more project in this fiscal year. CMAQ balance of \$4M and likely to carry into next year. HIP funds for Overlay Project expected to be obligated in 2023.

b. Progress Updates from KCMO – Nicolas Bosonetto

- i. Request for multiple projects to be shifted to the 2023 fiscal year due to issues with COVID and right-of-way. Projects include:
 - 1. KCI Corridor Trail Segments 1, 2, & 3
 - 2. Route 152 Trail Segment 12
 - 3. Lexington Gladstone Bikeways
 - 4. Paseo Boulevard Bikeways – public wants more investment in shared use sidewalks instead of street bike lanes.
 - 5. 11th and 12th Street Bikeways – In the process of redesign
 - 6. Independence Ave. Cycletrack
 - 7. Gillham Road Bikeways – Intersection analysis issue
- ii. Next meeting, approval will be held prior to next round of funding for committee programming activity.

c. Other Project Status Updates –

- i. Jackson County

1. Greenwood Connector
 - a. Request to move timeline into early 2023.
 - b. Project is still undergoing right-of-way procurement
2. Little Blue Trace/ Rock Island Connector
 - a. Request to move timeline into 2023.
 - b. Waiting for KCMO Floodplain Permit and other items to move forward.
- ii. Kansas City, Missouri
 1. Vision Zero Action Plan passed Transportation Committee during Council and with full support of members, will be adopted.
- iii. City of Independence
 1. Truman Road Depot Renovations and Pacific Avenue Trail is awaiting a signed agreement in order to proceed toward obligation.
 2. Truman Connect
 - a. Request to move project to 2023, currently at the environmental stage.
- iv. Johnson County
 1. Comprehensive Safe Routes to School Program
 - a. Paperwork for the allotment is expected to be completed very soon.
- v. Riverside
 1. Vivion Road Trail Segment 1
 - a. Right-of-way plans will soon be completed and submitted. Construction is likely not to start until next year.
