
CENSUS PROFILE Jackson County, Missouri

In 2020, Jackson County, Missouri, remained the most populous county in the nine-county MARC Region with 717,204 persons. Representing one-third of the region's total residents, Jackson County grew 6.4% from 2010. Jackson County has experienced stronger growth since 1990, recovering from population losses between 1970 and 1980.


Jackson County added 43,046 persons during the decade. This ranked second in the MARC region and was due to both a natural increase (births over deaths) of 29,588 residents and a net inmigration of 13,458 persons.


Population change by race and ethnicity mirrors the region's trend with all (100%) of the county's growth due to increases in persons of color. Persons of color saw their share of the county's population increase from approximately 37% in 2010 to 42% in 2020.

The largest increases in population by race and ethnicity were experienced with two or more races, Hispanic and Asian and Pacific Islander alone. Black and white populations both experienced an actual decrease in numbers over the decade.




Components of Population Change, 2010–2020


