
## R CENSUS PROFILE Wyandotte County, Kansas

In 2020, Wyandotte County, Kansas, was the fourth most populous county in the nine-county MARC Region with 169,245 persons. Representing nearly one-tenth of the region's total residents, Wyandotte County grew 7% from 2010. This reversed a four-decade population loss that started in 1970.


Wyandotte County added 11,740 persons during the decade. This was due to both a natural increase (births over deaths) of 12,164 residents and a net out-migration of 424 persons. Population change by race and ethnicity mirrors the region's trend with all (100%) of the county's growth due to increases in persons of color.

Wyandotte County remains the region's only county that is majority people of color. Their share of the county's population stayed relatively steady at 62.7%, increasing only slightly from 62.4% in 2010.


This stability resulted from the county losing Black and white population in roughly equal numbers. The largest increases in population by race and ethnicity were experienced by individuals identifying as Hispanic, Asian and Pacific Islander alone, and two or more races.




## Components of Population Change, 2010–2020




## **Population Composition by Race and Ethnicity**
