- 1. Welcome, Introductions**
Co-Chair Nancy Tausz called the meeting to order and self-introductions were made.
- 2. Perfect Storm Video**
Dan Manley presented a video from the April 7, 2010 mass causality exercise.
- 3. RHSCC Governance up Date**
Larry Jones reported on the reorganization of Regional Homeland Security Coordinating Committee. In the restructuring, each region will have a representative based on their population. Mr. Jones felt that this would not affect the Public Health Subcommittee directly.

4. Task Force Reports

- **SNS**

Trailer – Tim Gridley reported the Platte County trailer is almost complete. Additionally the resupply of all the trailers is almost complete.

Communications – Dan Manley reported that the purchase orders have been issued for the radio equipment and reported on the interoperability project's progress.

- **Risk Communication**

Discussed a press conference scheduled for Friday.

- **Plans, Training and Exercise**

Dispensing Exercise- Bonnie Martin reported that the design team will meet every other week. They are also targeting rural communities for operating a dispensing site.

Ms. Martin advised that the improvement items addressed in the After Action report from the fall 2009 event are being included in this exercise.

- **ESIQ**

Lisa Hubbert reported that they are working on scheduling a meeting with X-Sentinel Systems to discuss the reports on the data that each Kansas and Missouri are providing.

Ms. Hubbert reported that they are on schedule for an isolation and quarantine exercise.

- **Environmental Health**

Donna Martin reviewed the matrix that was generated from the Environmental Health survey. Ms. Martin advised that she will be reworking the document so that it is easier to understand. The Environmental Health group discussed sharing ordinances.

3. Committee Reports

- **Training and Exercise**

Bonnie Martin advised that they conducted a mid-year review of the three year training calendar. The purpose of the mid-year review is to determine whether the planned training is still applicable to the committees' needs.

They discussed funding transfer from this quarter to the fourth quarter.

- **Project Measurement –**

They looked at capabilities and assessment of agriculture Environmental Health and food protection prior to retail.

- **Hospitals-** Dan Manley reviewed the planning for the Hospitals fall exercise scheduled for October 13th. Mr. Manley reported that they will be using the evacuation equipment recently purchased.

- **MARCER-** Continuing work on time critical diagnosis (STEMI/Stroke) protocols for the region and with the state.

- **TEW-** Discussed the reports that are generated out of their office. If you are not receiving those bulletins please let Tanya Kraatz know and she will work on getting your name of the distribution list.
- **CRI**
Kansas- Lougene Marsh advised that as of the next grant year, Johnson County will assume the financial responsibility of the Kansas CRI grant.

Kevin Kovach reported that the registration for the SNS Summit will close tomorrow and is being held July 21- 29. If you haven't heard about your scholarship, you may want to contact them.

The new grant guidance requires a score of 69% to continue receiving funding. The RAN drills are being completed.

Kevin Kovach advised that he has a catalog of the SNS push packages if you would like a copy let Mr. Kovach know.

Missouri – Patrick Morgester advised that the TAR reviews are underway, Platte County received a 99%.

4. Other Business

Earthquake Drill - Larry Jones reported that he received notice of a table top drill that is being held in preparation of the Full Scale Exercise for April 2011. C. Jon Hinkle advised that every region will be holding these table tops to test the local system, prior to the April 2011 exercise.

CDP Training – Gay Hall reminded all of the PAPER and MGT360 training June 21-25, 2010, 8 hours each day.

H1N1 Hot Wash- Lougene Marsh reported on the effectiveness of the recent H1N1 Hot Wash meeting.

MRC – Kevin Kovach announced that June 29th will be Charlie Bryan's last day as the Medical Reserve Corps coordinator.

Special Presentation – Larry Jones presented Danyel Olsen with a Certificate of Appreciation for her work with ESIQ and announced that she will be relocating to the East Coast.
