### Summary

1. Jim Hubbell called the meeting to order and began the welcome and introductions.
2. The first order of business was committee review and approval of the January 2010 Aviation Advisory Committee meeting summary.
3. Next, general updates were provided by local airport staff.

Melissa Cooper, Wheeler Downtown Airport, reported that work is underway on the development of its general aviation terminal, new hangars, and the installation of EMAS on the north end of runway 1-19.

Michael McDonald, City of Leavenworth, announced that an aviation security plan is being developed for the Sherman Army Airfield FBO.

John Ohrazda, Lee’s Summit Municipal Airport, reported that the airport is developing its planning documents. Mr. Ohrazda will offer more information on the airports plans in a presentation to the Committee in May.

4. Ed Young, KDOT, reported that KDOT is developing a navigational hazards overlay application with funds from the 2010 System Planning Grant. The application will assist KDOT with identifying and addressing hazards to air navigation.
5. Mark Schenkelberg, FAA, informed everyone that the FAA is operating under another 3-month continuing resolution authorized by Congress.

6. Frank Lenk, Director of Research Services at MARC, gave a presentation on the alternative forecast scenarios developed by MARC for Transportation Outlook 2040, the region's long-range transportation plan.
