1. **Approval of January 11, 2012 Meeting Summary** – On the motion and second of Valerie Miller and Jake Jacobs the January 11, 2012 meeting summary was approved.
2. **Job Access and New Freedom Update** – Jim Courtney and Stewart Nelson provided a comprehensive overview of the JARC and New Freedom competitive selection process (including regulations, planning requirements, compliance issues, and contractor status i.e., designated recipient, grant recipient, sub-recipient, and third-party contractor).

In the absence of the designated recipient the committee directed to the three-page project summary provided by Tracey Logan. The committee reviewed the FFY 2006-07, FFY 2008-09, and FFY2010-11 projects and contracts for JARC and New Freedom between the FTA and the KCATA.

A discussion of the Department of Labor (DOL) review and response letters ensued. Courtney directed the committee to the section titled “Protection of Employment” on page 6 of a DOL response letter. Joni Roeseler of the FTA informed the committee of the function of the DOL review and response. The JARC Program has a DOL requirement, but the New Freedom Program does not.

FYI – The program for Veterans (VTCLI) also has a DOL review/response component.

Roeseler informed the committee that local labor union requirements can be found in Section 5333(b) of Title 49 US Code. The following DOT programs require Department of Labor certification: Section 5307, Section 5309 (including VTCLI projects), Section 5310, and Section 5316. A transit agency that applies for JARC funding, under the DOL agreement, would have to list area unions. FTA is not involved with labor organizations of their labor negotiations; FTA wants to assure that labor is addressed within applications for federal funds.

3. **Stakeholder/Peer Presentations** – Debra Parson with **Comprehensive Mental Health Services, Inc.** presented an overview of CMHS services. CMHS provides a wide range of mental health services to

Jackson County (MO) residents. CMHS is a safety net for those in poverty needing timely mental health services and care. At any given time the client population is close to 4000 persons. Of that 4000, 97% live within 200% of the poverty level and 84% are below the poverty level. Most of CMHS's patients are out-patient (one of the few Missouri programs that will go and pick up residents for out-patient services), but there are many services that offer residential programs (most consisting of 30-day stays). Many residential patients are homeless.

Parson introduced Michael Williams, who also works for CMHS, and he explained the relationship between CMHS and STAC-JARC. CMHS supplies substantial transportation services to patients for drug & alcohol programs, detox, and abuse centers. CMHS is one of very few agencies that allow women enrolled in drug and/or alcohol programs to bring their children to stay with them for up to a year. Parson ended her presentation by informing the committee that CMHS also offers training to agencies to recognize mental health issues of their employees and how to offer them help.

Jake Jacobs gave a brief presentation over the **Developmental Disability Services of Jackson County, EITAS**, and recent grant from MoDOT. Jacobs explained that EITAS offers services to Jackson County residents that have disabilities. EITAS transports 500 individuals daily (400 individuals through the services they operate and 100 through contracted services, like OATS, Inc.). EITAS provides door-to-door services during the day, runs fixed-route services, and with the money they are to receive from MoDOT's SFY 2010 Section 5310 Program EITAS plans to purchase two vans that will allow them to supply their own on-demand service which includes operating a 9AM-9PM Monday-Saturday service and providing trips to grocery stores, doctors' offices, and recreational activities. EITAS also applied for Section 5317 New Freedom grant funding in 2009.

4. **TIP 101** – Marc Hansen of MARC staff provided a PowerPoint presentation describing the federal requirements for a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP is a core product of MARC's Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) "programming" process (23 C.F.R. 450.324). The TIP acts to implement the Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and Congestion Management Services by positioning construction and transit projects within a short-range capital planning/programming document.

Included in the TIP are surface transportation projects, all "regionally significant" projects (i.e., any project that adds capacity to roads classified as a minor arterial or higher), and project descriptive information. For a project to be entered into the TIP the project must have designated federal funding since the TIP documents commitment of federal funding to local projects. MARC develops a new TIP for the KC region bi-annually (this usually takes place in September), and TIP amendments occur quarterly at no cost to project sponsors or on a special agenda as offers are needed (in this case, project sponsors are responsible for costs). The respective state departments of transportation, MoDOT and KDOT, may include MARC's TIP into their State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP). Both TIPS and STIPs may then be provided to the respective federal DOT divisions (FHWA or FTA) based upon funding requests.

Carroll Ramseyer of the City of Olathe and President of Kansas Coordinated Transit District #1 (CTD #1) briefed the committee on the methodology used by the State of Kansas to fund mobility/transit programs (e.g., Section 5310). Jim Perez and Scott Lein of KDOT's transit section explained that KDOT may reconsider the statewide CTD system that is used to allocate funds.

An informal understanding was reached that MARC would amend the KDOT TIP projects following KDOT making and notifying MARC of awards.

5. **MARC Local Match** – Mell Henderson, MARC’s Director of Transportation, presented a proposed local match programming fee.

MARC has historically relied on in-kind match to meet the required \$750,000-\$775,000 in local match for the federal Consolidated Planning Grant (CPG). Mell presented a proposed method to meet the required local match for CPG as it has become increasingly difficult to self-generate the necessary in-kind match. Project fees for MARC selected projects would be 0.5% (half of 1%) of a project’s total cost (i.e., \$5,000 for every \$1 million of project costs). MARC will continue to use dues collected from local governments and in-kind as match for CPG funds, but with the additional proposed 0.5% project fee.

Shawn Strate, Johnson County Transit, asked how this proposed fee compares with other MPOs method of meeting local match obligations. Mell explained that the method in which MPOs handle the generation of local match varies. MARC got the idea for a proposed fee from St. Louis’ Council of Governments, East-West Gateway. Mell went on to explain that the fee would be a one-time fee charged to project sponsors, and the amount charged would reflect the amount the committee has chosen to allocate for that particular project.

The STAC-JARC Committee expressed concern that smaller transit organizations would be burdened financially if forced to provide project fees. Mell commented that applicants in St. Louis pay a fee with their application, and those projects that aren’t selected are reimbursed the project application fee. Mell informed the committee that there are still lots of questions to answer before the MARC Board will vote to implement the proposed project fee.

6. **Segway Presentation** – Due to time restrictions this presentation was delayed until a future date. Stewart Nelson did request that any committee members having experience with Segways please contact MARC Staff.
7. **VTCLI Update** – Tyler Means and Ron Achelpohl, MARC Transportation Staff, presented the current status of the VTCLI project. MARC’s currently in the process of drafting agreements with 2 of the project sub-recipients (KUMC and UMKC) and a potential 3<sup>rd</sup> party contractor. A next step is to finalize a Transportation Electronic Award Management (TEAM) application with FTA. The VTCLI project will be integrated into MARC’s TIP and the State of Missouri STIP.

Joni Roeseler, FTA, introduced the second funding cycle for VTCLI projects (the press release and NOFA were provided as a handout) and explained that in order to apply you have to be a public agency.

8. **MARC’s annual Area Agency on Aging Request-for-Proposal** –Nelson indicated the MARC Area Agency on Aging’s RFP process is now underway and provided a tentative planning schedule.

MARC as the Missouri Area Agency on Aging in the Kansas City Region allocates approximately \$600,000 through the RFP process. Applications are due at noon on March 6, 2012, and applicant presentations will be provided at the March 14<sup>th</sup> meeting of STAC-JARC.
