### Statewide Numbers

**33,000** children are being raised by a relative or kinship caregiver without a parent at home.

**29,452** grandparents are raising grandchildren.

Caregivers choose from a list of approved Day Camps throughout the region, and the base fees are waived for children ages 5-17.

#### **GRAND***Pass* gives older caregivers:

- Needed relief from caregiving tasks and expenses
- Peace of mind knowing that their children are being cared for in a safe and structured environment

#### **GRAND***Pass* gives children:

- Freedom to learn and grow
- Access to the outdoors
- Exposure to new activities and experiences
- Opportunities for socialization



### First and Second Year Facts

*Total participants: 60* (24 first year, 36 second year) *Total families helped:* 18

Community Partnerships : 2 (YMCA and Camp Wildwood across 5 sites)

*Cost:* \$150-175/week
