DOWNTOWN STREETCAR GOALS & RESULTS

CONNECT:14M+ passenger trips

DEVELOP: Record setting development levels along the route (surface lot conversions, new mixed use, hotels, etc.)

THRIVE: 98% of businesses on route indicate positive impact on business

SUSTAIN: 77% public satisfaction vs. 7% dissatisfied + strong TDD performance (revenues sufficient to purchase 2 additional streetcars to meet demand and fund planning for expansion)

RIVERFRONT EXTENSION

- Broke ground March 2024
- Estimated completion early 2026
- Extension is ¾ mile, connecting downtown to Berkley Riverfront
- 2 additional streetcar stops

Track Construction Progress 41% Complete

Updated as of October 3, 2024

Approximately 8,329 feet of track will be installed for the .7 mile extension to connect to the existing KC Streetcar system.
