## REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

## **BACKGROUND**

The Mid-America Regional Council (MARC) is a nonprofit association of city and county governments and the metropolitan planning organization for the Kansas City region. MARC promotes regional cooperation and develops innovative solutions while providing a forum for the region to work together to advance social, economic, and environmental progress.

Capitalizing well-established community connections, MARC Head Start serves as the grantee for Head Start and Early Head Start programs in metropolitan Kansas City, Missouri, as well as Clay, Jackson, and Platte Counties. Through a network of contracted direct service providers, MARC Head Start serves approximately 2,300 children and their families residing in the above-mentioned counties. The programs offer comprehensive, high-quality early education services for children from birth to five years and pregnant women, promoting healthy development in areas such as physical and social/emotional growth. These services prepare children for school success through both center-based and home visiting programs. Additionally, the programs include support for children eligible for services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

MARC Head Start's network of providers operates within a three-tier structure based on each agency's capacity to serve children and their families while maintaining high-quality standards. Tiers 1 and 2 consist of direct service providers that serve fewer than 200 Head Start/Early Head Start (HS/EHS) children, while Tier 3 programs serve 200 or more children and their families. **See Exhibit A for a list of all sites.** 

As the grantee, MARC Head Start supports these programs by forming strategic partnerships and providing technical assistance and monitoring to ensure compliance with Head Start Performance Standards. Additionally, specialized contractual agreements with community agencies and consultants are also provided to assist in delivering comprehensive services for Head Start children, families, and pregnant women. Therefore, we are seeking a Maternal Health Specialist (Doula) to offer non-medical, family-centered support to prenatal and postpartum mothers enrolled in the Early Head Start home-based programs. The Maternal Health Specialist (Doula) will collaborate with the MARC Head Start Health Manager and Health Coordinator to enhance access to prenatal and postpartum care, promote healthy birth outcomes and postpartum recovery, support emotional and physical well-being during pregnancy and after childbirth, equip families with tools for informed decision-making as well as connections to community resources.

MARC Head Start is seeking individuals who have experience in maternal health and doula services. Certified/Certificate Doula or Associate's in a heath related field is required.

# SCOPE OF WORK

- Provide consultation, coordination of services, training, and support of maternal health services for Tier 1 & 2 Early Head Start home-based programs within the MARC Head Start network.
- Maintain a thorough knowledge and understanding of all aspects of the Head Start Performance Standards.
- Collaborate with direct service providers to offer maternal health education sessions and
  early parenting workshops that provide families with practical caregiving tools for
  prenatal and postpartum periods. Topics may cover safe sleep practices, diapering and
  soothing techniques, breastfeeding support, and routines for newborn care routines.
- Participate in the triage process to identify and prioritize family needs, including access
  to health services, emotional support, and community resources to ensure timely referrals,
  individualized care planning, and coordinated follow-up that reflects each family's
  unique circumstances and strengths.
- Conduct a 2-week postpartum home visit to assess maternal and infant physical and emotional wellness, followed by ongoing check-ins to monitor healing, bonding, feeding routines, and family adjustment. Identify emerging concerns, reinforce care plans, and ensure families remain connected to appropriate support services.
- Establish and maintain partnerships with maternal health organizations and safety-net clinics to strengthen care coordination, expand access to services, and connect families to trusted providers throughout the prenatal and postpartum journey. These partnerships will enhance referral pathways and promote continuity of care.
- Track maternal health engagement by collecting baseline and post-intervention data to
  evaluate outcomes, measure service utilization, and identify opportunities for continuous
  improvement and targeted support.
- Document all home-visits, wellness check-ins, referrals, and training in the ChildPlus data system to maintain accurate monitoring and reporting.
- Support the Health Manager with the American Heart Association Postpartum Systems of Care Initiative.
- Participate in MARC Head Start Health Services Advisory Committee Meetings.
- Attend monthly meetings (in person or virtually) with the Health Manager and Health Coordinator to review service needs, assess barriers, and develop strategies to enhance access and support.

# **Funding Timeframes:**

- The terms of this contract will begin on **February 2**, **2026** and be reviewed yearly.
- The contract will extend from February 2, 2026 through October 31, 2026.
- Thereafter, MARC may extend the term of the contract for up to four additional periods. This
  extension is contingent upon successful performance and services provided, and upon
  availability of funds.
- All awards are provisional pending approval of the MARC's federal grant application by The Administration for Children and Families.
  - Should a respondent's contract be terminated or relinquished for any reason, MARC

reserves the right to return to the pool of respondents generated from this RFQ to select another qualified respondent.

Budget is based on an estimated 15 hours per week / 60 hours per month, these hours may fluctuate based on the time of year and schedule of activities. In some months, the hours may be more and in others, such as the summer months, the hours may be less.

 Selected candidate / agency should be aware that this is a federally funded project and as such the contract will be subject to all terms and conditions applicable to federal grants. Selected candidate must also provide documentation of a clear criminal background check and TB screening.
