**1. Welcome and Introductions**

Committee Vice Chair Jose Leon welcomed the attendees and asked for self-introductions. The meeting was again held virtually via Zoom.

**2. Approval of Meeting Summary**

MOTION: Chuck Soules moved and Chris Sandie seconded, to approve the January 11, 2021 meeting summary as submitted. The motion passed.

**3. MoDOT Updates**

Mike Landvik reported the 2023-2027 STIP was in process and an update would be shared at the next meeting. Ron Achelpohl added that funding levels were still uncertain in the upcoming bill. MoDOT is identifying additional projects for possible programming.

**4. 2025-2026 Call for Projects**

Marc Hansen reviewed the timeline and reviewed the following amounts based on the 2021 obligation limitations; however, MARC anticipates these targets may increase in all the programs, especially TAP, for FFY 2025-2026. More details should be available by the March 8<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Staff encouraged attendance at the policy workshop at 1 pm, February 9<sup>th</sup> to review the CMAQ, TAP and STP policies and how well they line up with the transportation Plan.

Marc Hansen reviewed the upcoming Call for Projects schedule.

Updated timeline for the 2022 Call for Projects Preliminary Schedule – Phase I: (still subject to change)

Notification of funding opportunity and pre-application website opens - March 3

Phase I Pre-application Workshop - March 10

Phase I Pre-applications due - April 1.

MARC staff review proposals - Complete by late April.

Committee survey - Open by late April/early May to check how well projects align with MARC's 2050 Plan.

Planning/Policy Committee review - Complete by June 10.

2022 Call for Projects Preliminary Schedule – Phase II:

Phase II Call for proposals opens and the application website opens - June 16

Phase II Application Workshop - June 23.

Phase II Applications due - July 22.

MARC staff review and score applications - Complete by September 16.

Programming Committee review and develop funding recommendations by December 9.

TTPC release the recommendations for public review and comment - December 20, 2022

TTPC/MARC Board approval - January 17/24, 2023.

**5. Reasonable Progress Report**

Marc Hansen shared and MoDOT confirmed minimal changes since last month's meeting which is normal this time of year. MARC shared the current list of programmed projects for FY 2022. The list showed the reduced STP amount for Kansas City's Waukomis Complete Streets project since the committee approved it to receive the available \$2.7M Highway Infrastructure Program (HIP) funds, therefore reducing the STP amount to \$2.3M.

Lists of the programmed STP and CMAQ Traffic Flow FY 2023 and FY 2024 projects were also shown:

- STP FY 2023 with eight projects totaling \$11,850,622
- STP FY2024 with seven projects totaling \$16,255,600.
- CMAQ FY 2023/2024 with two projects totaling \$1,604,690.

**6. Other Business**

Attendees were encouraged to submit recommendations for Regional Leadership Awards as detailed on MARC's website. Awardees would be recognized at MARC's Annual Meeting in June.

Mike Landvik announced this was his last STP meeting and his last day with MoDOT would be February 25th. He accepted a job in Ft. Worth, TX. Congratulations were given.

With no further business, a motion was approved to adjourn at 1:55 p.m.
