

2020 CENSUS PROFILE

Cass County, Missouri

In 2020, Cass County, Missouri, was the fifth most populous county in the nine-county MARC Region with 107,824 persons.

Representing 5% of the region's total residents, the county grew 8.4% from 2010 when the population was 99,499. Cass County has experienced steady growth since 1960.


Cass County added 8,346 persons during the decade. This was due to both a natural increase (births over deaths) of 2,372 and a net in-migration of 5,974 persons. Population change by race and ethnicity mirrors the region's trend with most (96%) of the county's growth due to increases in persons of color. Persons of color saw their share of the county's population increase from approximately 11% in 2010 to 17% in 2020.

The largest increases in population by race and ethnicity were experienced by individuals identifying as two or more races Hispanic, or Black alone. The white population remained relatively steady.


Cass County Total Population 1960 – 2020




Components of Population Change, 2010–2020



Population Composition by Race and Ethnicity





Population Change, 2010–2020
