

2020 CENSUS PROFILE

Miami County, Kansas

In 2020, Miami County, Kansas, was the eighth most populous county in the nine-county MARC Region with 34,191 persons. Representing less than 2% of the region's total residents, Miami County grew a modest 4.3% during the 2010s. The county has historically grown steadily since 1970.

Miami County added 1,404 persons during the decade. This was due to both a natural increase (births over deaths) of 744 residents and a net in-migration of 660 persons.


Population change by race and ethnicity mirrors the region's trend with all (100%) of the county's growth due to increases in persons of color. Persons of color saw their share of the county's population increase from 6% in 2010 to approximately 11% in 2020.

The largest increases in population by race and ethnicity were experienced by individuals identifying as two or more races and Hispanic. The white population experienced a slight decline in numbers over the decade.

1960 – 2020




Components of Population Change, 2010–2020



Population Composition by Race and Ethnicity


