

## A dozen or more opportunities to collaborate, such as:

- Providing more forums to expose what's really needed
- Expanding partnerships among schools, faith-based organizations, social services and government
- Elevate public awareness
- Expand service-oriented response models such as mental health coresponders and law enforcement homeless outreach



### **KEY CHALLENGES**

- Public will
  - Awareness of the issues perception may not match reality
- Political will
  - Resources and strategies to address root causes



### IDEAS WITH THE MOST POTENTIAL FOR ACTION

- Work with social service agencies to identify and resource small scale cold weather emergency shelters
- Work with UMKC to promote and sustain the homelessness asset inventory
- Focus on prevention (i.e. proactive utility assistance)
