MINUTES

1. Welcome and Introductions (Selina Bur)

Introductions were made. See attendance for those present.

2. Approve September 28th Meeting Summary (Selina Bur)

The September 28th Meeting Summary was approved unanimously by committee members.

3. I-35 & I-29 PEL Study Update (Juan Yin and Kip Strauss)

Juan Yin and Kip Strauss provided an update on the I-35 & I-29 Study presentation given in July 2022. The project area was reviewed and where they are in the planning process was described. They are currently in the process of screening for Reasonable Alternatives. The project team has developed the Baseline Conditions Report which is available on MoDOT's website. Kip Strauss reviewed baseline conditions, including demographics, traffic conditions, etc. There is a lot of traffic movement going in and out of downtown Kansas City, including significant freight activity. Kip reviewed origin-destination analyses findings, existing transit service, pedestrian and bicycle networks, substandard conditions, bridges of concern, etc. Kip reviewed the refined Purpose & Need and Screening of Alternatives. Juan announced the project next steps including upcoming agency meetings, public involvement, and provided a link to a self-guided presentation for the last public meeting.

4. <u>2021 Performance Measures – Safety, Pavement and Bridge Condition, and System Performance</u> (Selina Bur)

Selina Bur provided an update on the region's 2021 Performance Measures for safety, pavement and bridge condition, and system performance. Fatalities have been on the rise since 2015 and serious injuries since 2018. Non-motorized injuries and fatalities have seen a sharp spike in recent years as well. Our transportation system reliability measures are continuing to perform well. Some of our infrastructure condition measures is performing well, while others are not. Next steps include setting

pavement and bridge condition and system reliability targets for 2023. These targets will be brought to the Highway Committee in March 2023, and subsequently to TTPC.

5. 2023 Workplan (Selina Bur)

Key tasks and discussion topics for the next year include:

- Support Connected KC 2050 MTP Update: Confirm goals and strategies, update financial capacity analysis, and develop scenario analysis
- Review Complete Street Network Assessment & Complete Street Policy, as necessary
- Consider Functional Classification Changes and ConnectedKC 2050 Plan amendments, as necessary
- Performance management/target setting: Update the required USDOT (FAST Act) performance measures as necessary
- Review Congestion Management policies and processes
- Review updated fiscal constraint analysis reflecting new transportation funding (tentative)

The frequency of the functional classification calls was discussed and MARC posed the idea of having a call once a year versus twice a year. Input was received that it may be beneficial to have these calls more ahead of calls for funding. A suggestion was made to offer the call twice a year ahead of the calls for funding and once a year otherwise. MARC staff will follow-up with MoDOT staff after the Highway Committee meeting to receive their input.

No other comments were made with regard to the workplan. A final workplan will be provided in January.

6. Roundtable Updates (Committee)

No additional committee member updates were shared with the committee during this meeting.

The committee adjourned at 2:20 PM.
