RGC Zone – Regional Common Talkgroups

- REG CALL may be used as a calling channel for the assignment of units on large incidents
- REG CALL may also be used to communicate with KC Scout

PS Disp – Regional calling talkgroup for communications between COMMUNICATIONS CENTERS (Should be monitored by all dispatch centers)

- PS DISP may also be used to broadcast significant incidents to alert other dispatch centers (i.e., bank robberies, shootings, etc.)

Reg Cm3 – Multi Agency Emergency Response Primary talkgroup *(to include pursuits and assist the officers)*

Reg Cm4 – Air to ground communications

Reg Cm5 – Alternate talkgroup if Reg Cm3 is in use

Reg Cm6 – Alternate talkgroup if Reg Cm3 is in use

Reg Cm7 – Primary multi-agency fireground operations

Reg Cm8 – Alternate talkgroup if Reg Cm7 is in use

Reg Cm9 – Alternate talkgroup if Reg Cm7 is in use
