



Statewide Numbers

33,000 children are being raised by a relative or kinship caregiver without a parent at home.

29,452 grandparents are raising grandchildren.

Caregivers choose from a list of approved Day Camps throughout the region, and the base fees are waived for children ages 5-17.

GRAND*Pass* gives older caregivers:

- Needed relief from caregiving tasks and expenses
- Peace of mind knowing that their children are being cared for in a safe and structured environment

GRAND*Pass* gives children:

- Freedom to learn and grow
- Access to the outdoors
- Exposure to new activities and experiences
- Opportunities for socialization



First and Second Year Facts

Total participants: 60 (24 first year, 36 second year) *Total families helped:* 18

Community Partnerships : 2 (YMCA and Camp Wildwood across 5 sites)

Cost: \$150-175/week








"We just feel like it's no man's land because we can't relate to the younger parents, but we're not on the same page as the older folks either."
