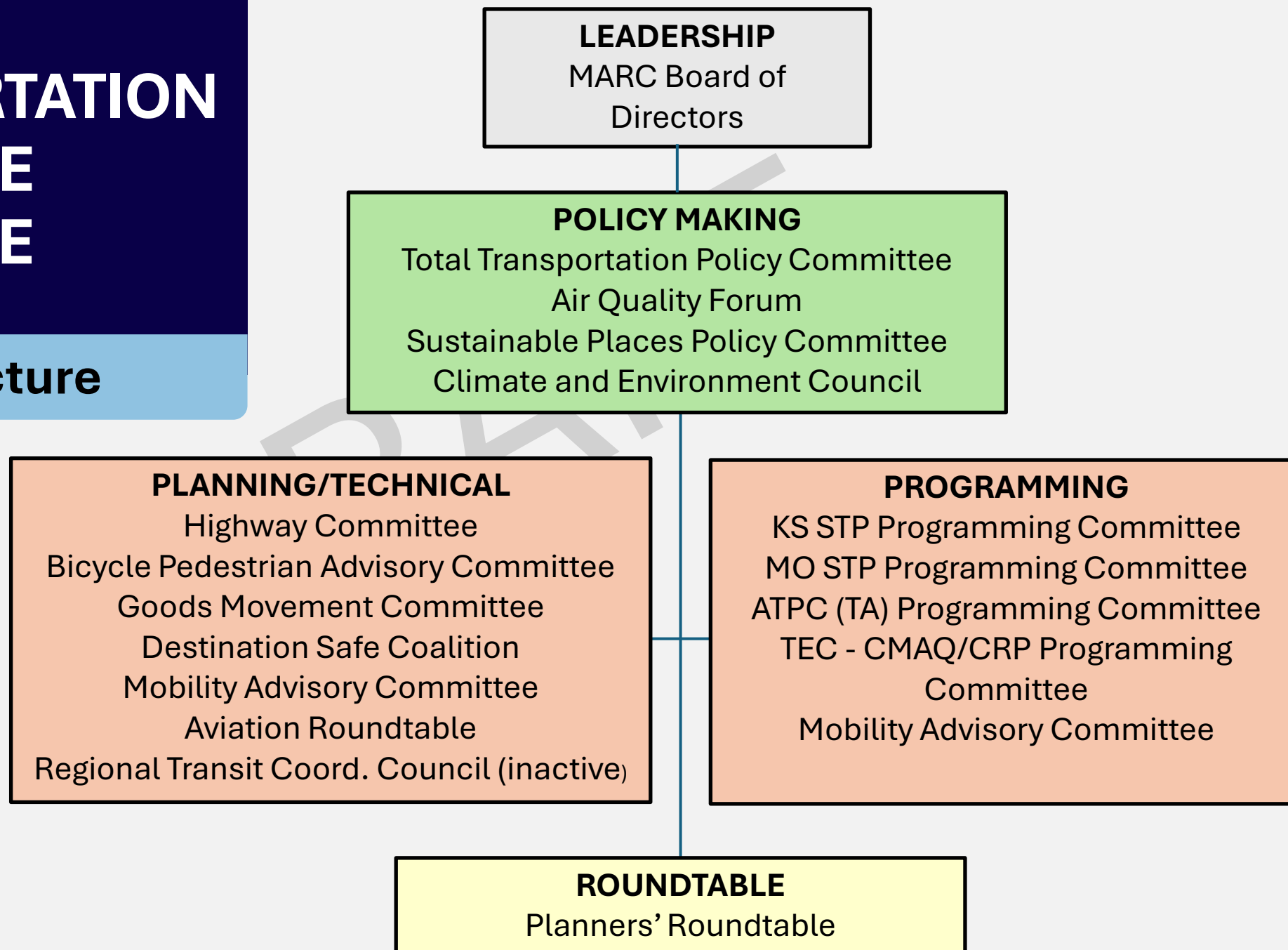

MARC TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REORGANIZATION

MPO Coordination Requirements from 23 CFR 450.300

- Continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive performance-based multimodal transportation planning process
- Stakeholders required for “cooperative” process:
 - State and local officials
 - Representatives of transit agencies, freight and other transportation modes
- Key deliverables:
 - Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)
 - Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
 - Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)
 - Public Participation Plan (PPP)
 - Congestion Management Process (CMP)
 - Performance Based Planning & Programming (PBPP)
 - Other plans & studies

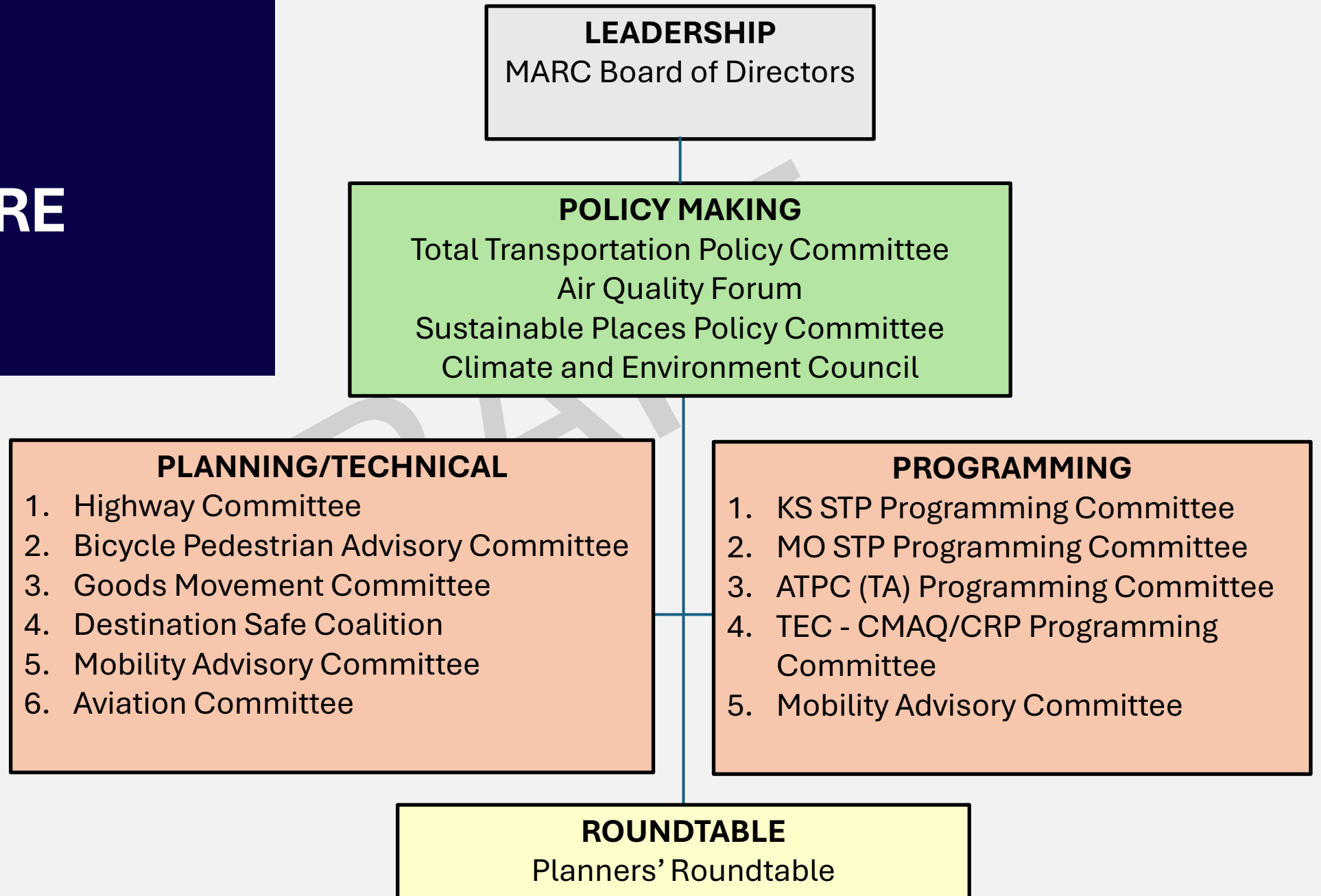

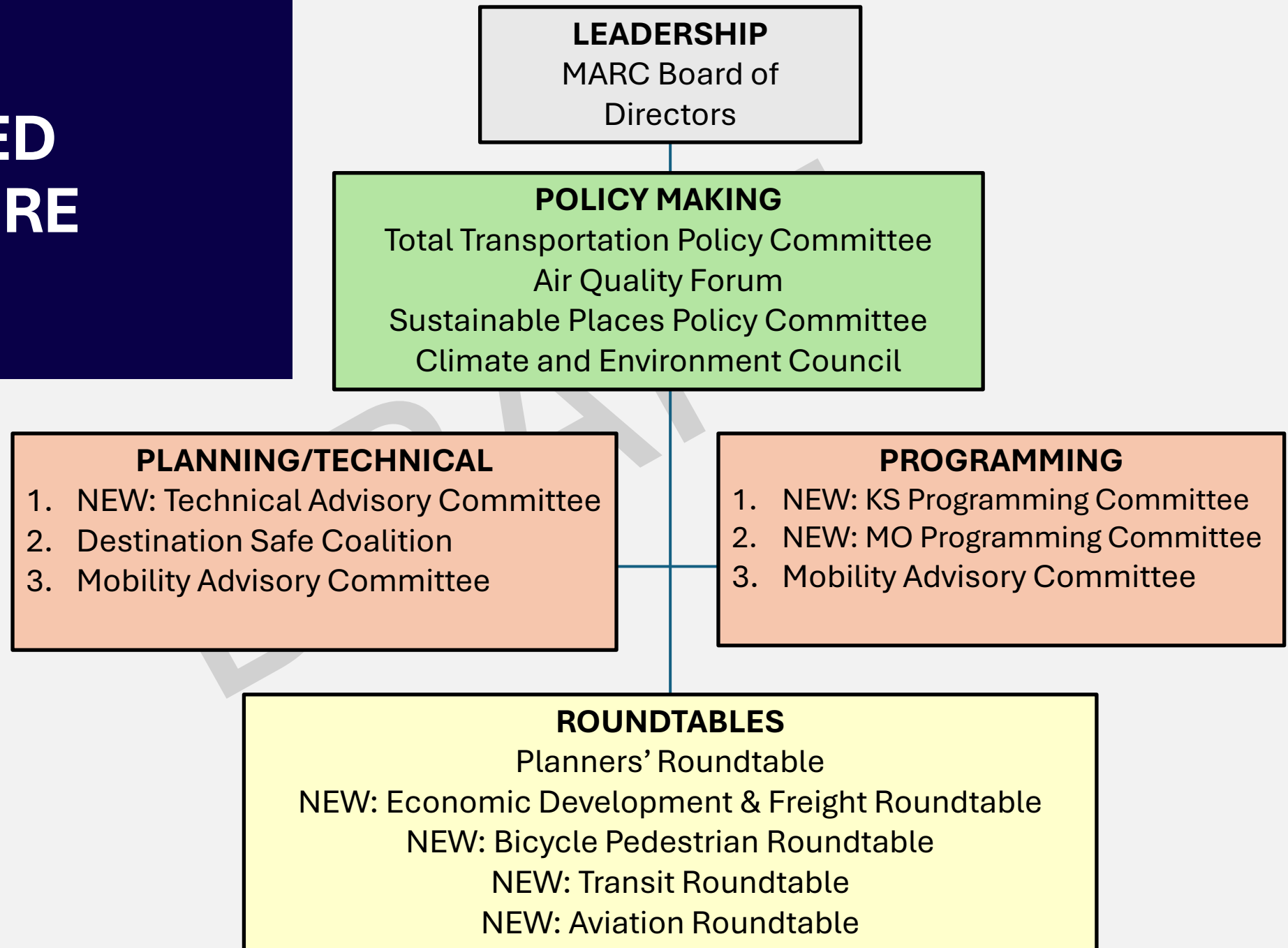
