1. Welcome and Introductions

Committee Chair Patty Hilderbrand welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order. Introduction of attendees followed.

2. Approve the June 10, 2025, Meeting Summary

Chuck Soules made a motion to approve the June 10, 2025 meeting summary, and Tom Degenhardt seconded the motion. The motion passed.

3. MoDOT Updates

The deadline for conditional Right of Way (ROW) clearance is August 1st. The Unfunded Needs list public meeting will be held at MARC from 4-6pm on August 14th.

4. Attendance Policy Modifications

The committee discussed proposed changes to the attendance policy in the committee's Roles & Responsibilities document to provide further clarification for member jurisdictions with multiple seats.

The proposed changes add clarifying language to the first paragraph of the attendance policy and removes the second paragraph, as indicated below (updated language in bold).

III. Attendance Policy:

Regular attendance at committee meetings promotes issue understanding and improves the working relationship among committee members. In order to retain voting membership, attendance by a jurisdiction (named member or alternate) at 60% of the committee meetings conducted in the 12-month period preceding the deadline for suballocated funding applications will be required to maintain voting membership. **For each meeting, the number of named members/alternates in attendance for each jurisdiction will be recorded; jurisdictions with multiple votes may vote according to the number of eligible votes in compliance with the attendance policy.**

~~The committee roster will be finalized 12 months prior to the deadline for suballocated funding applications. Modifications to the committee roster following the deadline for suballocated funding applications will be subject to committee approval. Requests for approval of new jurisdictional voting members may be made no later than 12 months after the completion of a suballocated funding round.~~

Jason Waldron made a motion to amend the attendance policy as indicated above, and AJ Farris seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The committee confirmed that membership is viewed as a collection for each jurisdiction, and that alternates can serve in place of any member for their respective jurisdiction. Attendance is recorded for all meetings, including special meetings. Rosters will be provided regularly to committee members, and changes to membership will be announced during introductions of meetings.

5. Program Status & Obligation Report

Harrisonville confirmed they will not make obligation on their two projects on the schedule for 2025.

KCATA has a project on the 2027 schedule for \$1m that could advance in the schedule if needed, but would need to be advanced in time to meet the FTA transfer window deadline. The schedule will still meet the 100% of the Obligation Limitation (OL) without the KCATA project advancing.

Marc Hansen reviewed the list of projects on the 2026 and 2027 schedules, which are overprogrammed. Projects may be asked to volunteer to move to future years in the schedule. The new 2026-2030 TIP will be released for public review and comment in September.

6. CRRSAA Regional Pavement Project

Final walkthroughs have been completed for the microsurfacing project, and change orders are still being processed with MoDOT to finalize the mill and overlay projects. Funds remain available in the engineering contract, and MARC is working with BHC to identify opportunities to utilize those funds. Jurisdictions affected by the project are encouraged to reach out to MARC to share feedback.

7. Federal Program

The committee discussed a letter released by the USDOT Secretary's office that indicates the administration is going to relax enforcement of requirements in existing grants for Justice 40, environmental justice, and climate provisions. MARC encouraged jurisdictions to read the letter carefully.

8. Other Business

The Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) application period is open from July 1, 2025-October 1, 2025. An estimated \$4.4m is available for programming for the entire state of Missouri, and additional information is available at highways.dot.gov/federal-lands/flap/mo.

MARC's Regional Assembly is Friday, June 13.

9. Adjournment

The next regularly scheduled meeting is Tuesday August 12, 2025. The meeting was adjourned.
