ISSUE:

VOTE to authorize an application to the Administration for Children and Families for a waiver of remaining Match Funds for FY25 for grant 07CH012381, Mid-America Regional Council Head Start Federal Grant.

BACKGROUND:

The Administration of Child and Families (ACF) funds 80 percent of the total operating cost of Head Start and Early Head Start grants. The remaining 20 percent must come from in-kind donations or matching funds from the community. These in-kind contributions must come from non-federal sources and must support necessary, reasonable and allowable costs for operating the program to be counted toward the 20 percent match. These contributions are generally in the form of volunteer services, donated or loaned equipment or space, donated supplies, land, or buildings.

The required federal match for the Head Start and Early Head Start grant ending October 31, 2025, is \$8,315,963.
