#### 1. Welcome and Introductions

Committee Chair Patty Hilderbrand welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order. Introduction of attendees followed.

#### 2. Approve the July 8, 2025, Meeting Summary

Chuck Soules made a motion to approve the July 8, 2025 meeting summary, and Tom Degenhardt seconded the motion. The motion passed.

#### 3. MoDOT Updates

Beth Peterson, new MoDOT planner, was introduced to the committee. The Unfunded Needs list public meeting will be held at MARC from 4-6pm on August 14. In-person basic LPA training dates are available across the state; October 9 in the Central District and October 29 the in Southwest district. The training is also available online. The Missouri Iowa Nebraska Conference (MINC) is scheduled for September 24-

25 in St. Joseph, and is currently open for registration. Additional information is available by contacting Melissa Schmitz or visiting the MoDOT website.

#### 4. **Program Modifications**

Blue Springs submitted a request to modify the scope of the Highway AA Improvements project, which was provided to the committee in advance of the meeting. Blue Springs had requested changes to funding and schedule at the June 10, 2025 committee meeting; the committee approved the schedule change and requested Blue Springs return to request final scope changes. Representatives from Blue Springs presented details on the scope change, and the committee discussed sidewalk placement and impacts on the residential community.

Sherri McIntyre made a motion to approve the scope modifications to the Highway AA Improvements project as presented. Chuck Soules seconded the motion. The motion passed.

#### 5. Policy Modifications

MARC last updated the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) policy in 2011. To address changes in the cost of project development and account for inflation since that time, MARC recommended increasing the financial modification threshold as shown below:

• Financial changes in a project's total programmed cost or programmed amount of federal funds greater than 25 percent or in excess of \$5 million \$10 million.

Xue Wood made a motion to amend the TIP policy as indicated above, and Pat Capranica seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Marc Hansen informed the committee of recent updates to the Roles and Responsibilities document; changes were made to the attendance policy per committee vote at the July meeting, as well as administrative updates for MPO membership (Ray County added to MARC MPO in 2023), population estimates, current language for Connected KC 2050, and project eligibility language for the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA). Population updates did not impact voting status for any members.

#### 6. Program Status & Obligation Report

KCATA's Regional Replacement Clean Vehicles project and Grandview's Blue Ridge Blvd Complete Streets Phase 1 project were advanced to the 2025 program from 2027. The current program is on track to meet obligation targets. Marc Hansen noted projects on the schedule for future years exceed financial capacity, and provided recommendations for balancing the program by shifting projects between future fiscal years. Mr. Hansen emphasized the importance of projects being on the schedule, and that projects can continue to shift around between years as needed through administrative modifications.

North Kansas City will be requesting to withdraw two projects from the 2026 program totaling \$10m, but indicated they will request a portion of the money to do some improvements included in the original scope. They do not appear on the schedule.

#### 7. Federal Program

US DOT has issued new guidance for the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) program.

#### 8. Other Business

Project fee invoices have been issued to city managers and administrators.

Beth Dawson shared that the Planning Sustainable Places (PSP) Program will be hosting a Vibrant Success Stories event on December 5, 2025, and is asking for project summaries from former PSP sponsors who have completed or are progressing towards implementing their projects. The deadline to apply is August 29.

Martin Rivarola shared that MARC will be hosting virtual workshops to discuss streamlining committees. Tentative dates include August 28, September 3, and September 9, all from 1:30-3:00pm. Invitations with more details will be sent to committee members by the end of the week.

The Traffic Engineering Assistance Program (TEAP) application for fiscal year 2026 is due August 29. The application is available at <a href="https://www.modot.org/node/72306">https://www.modot.org/node/72306</a>.

#### 9. Adjournment

The next regularly scheduled meeting is Tuesday September 9, 2025. The meeting was adjourned.


