### 3. Presentation: Kansas Traffic Safety Resource Office Program (20-30 min)

The KC2026 Transport team is made up of government transportation professionals, traffic incident management professionals, and consultants. This team will be working with regional stakeholders through engagement to execute a safe and efficient transportation system for this major sporting event.

KC2026 World Cup will be the single largest sporting event in the world with expected viewership at 1 billion; compared to the Super Bowl with 114 million viewers and NBA Finals with 25 million viewers. KC2026 World Cup will feature 48 teams, with 104 matches over 37 days (June 11 through July 19). Six matches will occur in Kansas City at the Arrowhead Stadium.



This event is anticipated to generate up to 600,000 visitors. Most visitors will likely be transit/rideshare dependent and from out of the country. This event will generate a lot of pedestrians who may communicate in different languages.

### 5. **Presentation: 2024 Destination Safe Public Awareness Campaign Final Report** (10 min)

Nordia Epps, MARC, gave an overview of the methods used and effectiveness of the June through August 2024 Destination Safe public awareness campaign. The primary goal of the campaign is to increase awareness of top safety behaviors or issues that have resulted in transportation-related fatal or serious injuries. The 2024 campaign budget was \$20,030 and was allocated through the following types of mediums:

Campaign messages focused on seat belt use, older drivers, speeding, helmet use, phones down, and pedestrians. This year MARC established a “[Get There Safe](#)” website landing page with safety resources and content messages. This website provides us with a new way to measure success through click rates.

### 6. Update: MARC-Destination Safe SS4A CSAP (10 min)

Alicia Hunter, MARC, provided an update on the procurement process and the next steps for the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan project. MARC issued an RFP from July 22 through August 19. The Consultant Selection Group scored submitted proposals and final interview presentations. The group was made up of the following members:

The scores for proposals and presentations were averaged separately then combined for each consultant and resulted in a ranking. The highest ranked consultant is Toole Design. MARC will begin contract negotiations with the highest ranked consultant and seek Board approval on October 22. Tentative fully executed contract and project start the first week of November.
