Missouri Programming Committee Meeting Summary

March 2026

1. Welcome and Introductions

Transportation Programs Manager Marc Hansen welcomed members and guests and called the meeting to order. Mr. Hansen informed the committee that the February 10, 2026 meeting summary was not previously included on the agenda, but since the summary was included in the meeting packet and the meeting did not contain any action items, he proposed adding approval of the summary to the agenda. Online guests were asked to introduce themselves in the chat, and self-introductions for in-person attendees followed. Attendance of this meeting is included at the end of this summary.

2. Vote: February 10, 2026 Meeting Summary

Mike Duffy moved to approve the February 10, 2026 meeting summary that was included in the meeting packet. Michael Park seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

3. Vote: Election of Committee Leadership

Committee members were given notice at the previous meeting of the election for committee chair and vice chair; elected positions are for two-year terms and would be approved by Total Transportation Policy Committee (TTPC) co-chairs.

Doug Wesselschmidt moved to elect Sherri McIntyre of Liberty, MO as Missouri Programming Committee Chair. Michael Park seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Doug Wesselschmidt moved to elect Todd La Torella of Kansas City, MO as Missouri Programming Committee Vice-Chair. Michael Park seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

4. Vote: Missouri Program Status and Obligations Report

Marc Hansen reviewed the 2026 balances for each program, including expected obligations. Over \$39m needs to be obligated across STBG, TA, CRP, and CMAQ programs, and projects are not making enough progress to meet obligations. The committee reviewed projects in each program, confirming obligation status and if any projects could utilize additional funding. Committee members shared some hesitation on providing additional funding/advancing projects that did not have Right of Way (ROW) approval expected within a month.

AJ Farris made a motion to approve the following changes to programs:

- Advance the following MARC and KCATA projects from the 2027 CMAQ program to 2026:
 - MARC - Regional Air Quality Public Education 2027-2028 (\$297,500)
 - MARC - Active Transportation Program 2027-2028 (\$38,000)
 - MARC - WAY TO GO Program 2027-2028 (\$235,000)
 - KCATA - New Bus and Micromobility Services (\$600,000)
 - KCATA - Expanded Flex Service (KS & MO) (\$400,000)

- Advance the Route 152 Trail from the 2027 CRP program to 2026:
 - Platte County - Route 152 Trail Completion Platte County (\$3,500,000)
- Advance the MARC PSP program from the 2027 STBG program to 2026 and transfer to FTA:
 - MARC - Planning Sustainable Places Program 2027 (\$500,000)

Michael Park seconded the motion, and the motion passed. Platte County commented that they may have trouble fully obligating this year, but could confirm the amount able to be obligated before adding to the TIP.

Project sponsors were asked to submit requests for any additional funds that can be obligated in 2026 or any advancements of projects on the schedule before the next MPC meeting. The committee discussed potentially requiring minimal project progress to stay on the program, including the consequences of such a policy.

5. Missouri Unfunded Needs

Transportation Planning Director Martin Rivarola reviewed the Missouri Unfunded Needs list, which includes Road/Bridge projects (split into three tiers) and Multimodal projects. Mr. Rivarola shared the list of projects for each list, including the cost targets set by MoDOT. Project lists are updated annually based on cost adjustments and projects coming off the list due to other funding/inclusion on the STIP. The draft lists will be distributed to the committee after the meeting for review and suggested changes, with a deadline for updates set for March 24, 2026.

6. 2026 Suballocated Call for Projects Update

Marc Hansen updated the committee on the schedule for the programming process, noting that the presentation from the March 5th Phase I application workshop is located on the [Suballocated Call for Projects website](#). The deadline for Phase I applications is Friday, March 20, 2026.

7. MARC Policy Review

8. Other Business

MARC is moving offices to 801 Pennsylvania this summer. Impacts to committee meetings in June, July, and August are expected due to the move, World Cup, and construction downtown. June and July MPC meetings are currently scheduled to meet at the MoDOT district office in Lee's Summit. The MARC annual meeting is set for August 14, 2026.

The meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the MPC is April 14, 2026.
