

Missouri Programming Committee Meeting Summary

May 2026

1. Welcome and Introductions

Missouri Programming Committee (MPC) Chair Sherri McIntyre welcomed members and guests and called the meeting to order. Online guests were asked to introduce themselves in the chat, and self-introductions for in-person attendees followed. Attendance of this meeting is included at the end of this summary.

2. Vote: April 14, 2026 Meeting Summary

Meeting minutes were not sent out ahead of time, so action on this item was deferred to the next meeting.

3. Vote: Missouri Program Status and Obligations Report

Transportation Program Manager Marc Hansen reviewed the city of Smithville's request for financial modifications. As discussed at the previous meeting, Smithville was in need of additional funding for the Bridge Street Roundabout project in order to obligate in 2026. Smithville requested \$400,000 of TA funding for their Riverwalk project be reallocated to the Bridge Street Roundabout project. Both projects are expected to obligate in 2026 with these changes.

Sabin Yanez made a motion to approve the reallocation of \$400,000 from Smithville's Riverwalk project to the Bridge Street Roundabout project. Tawn Nugent seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

4. Vote: Missouri Unfunded Needs

Transportation Planning Director Martin Rivarola reviewed the Missouri Unfunded Needs list, which was presented to the committee at the last meeting. The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) has reviewed and recommended the Unfunded Needs list for multimodal projects, and the aviation roundtable has provided advisory review for that list. The MPC is tasked with reviewing and approving the road/highway list, which splits projects across three tiers based on expected implementation and construction. Mr. Rivarola detailed the changes of projects on the list (including additions to/changes between tiers and cost updates), and the committee discussed individual projects and MoDOT priorities.

Tawn Nugent made a motion to approve the Missouri Unfunded Needs list. George Binger seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

5. 2026 Suballocated Call for Projects Update

Marc Hansen reviewed the upcoming schedule and process for scoring projects that applied for suballocated federal transportation funds. MARC staff have provided feedback to project sponsors on Phase I applications, and the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Total Transportation Policy Committee (TTPC) will evaluate assigned alignment statuses. Project sponsors will have an opportunity with their Phase II application to address those comments and improve their alignment status, and should notify MARC staff if they need to

update/reassign contact information prior to submitting Phase II applications. Applicants from Phase I will be notified when the call for projects opens on June 18, and a Phase II technical application workshop will be held June 25. The Phase II deadline is 4:00pm on July 24, 2026. Sponsors may request reconsideration/clarification of scores, but cannot make changes to their application once submitted (so applications should be as comprehensive as possible). MARC staff reviewed requirements, components, and categories for each funding program; scoring criteria and resources are available on the [MARC website](#).

Due to the consolidation of the programming committee structure, the project presentation process (which typically occurs between finalization of scoring and the first committee meeting to initiate programming recommendations) may be adjusted to account for the committee reviewing more applications. Special meetings outside of the monthly schedule will be set by the committee as needed.

6. MARC Planning Sustainable Places Call for Projects

Planning Sustainable Places (PSP) Program Manager Beth Dawson reviewed the recently opened call for projects for the PSP program, including funding by state, maximum awards, and match requirements. Two primary categories for projects are PSP plans and project development. Ms. Dawson reviewed the timeline of project assessment, review by the Sustainable Places Policy Committee, and recommendations and approval expected in September 2026.

7. Other Business

Marc Hansen noted that due to changes to MARC's schedules in the move of MARC offices, the June 9 meeting will be held at the in the Board Room at the MARC offices on 600 Broadway. No other business was called.

8. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the MPC is June 9, 2026. The June meeting will be held in the Board Room at the MARC offices on 600 Broadway. The July 14th meeting will be held at the MoDOT district office in Room 136 at 600 NE Colbern Rd, Lee's Summit, Missouri.
