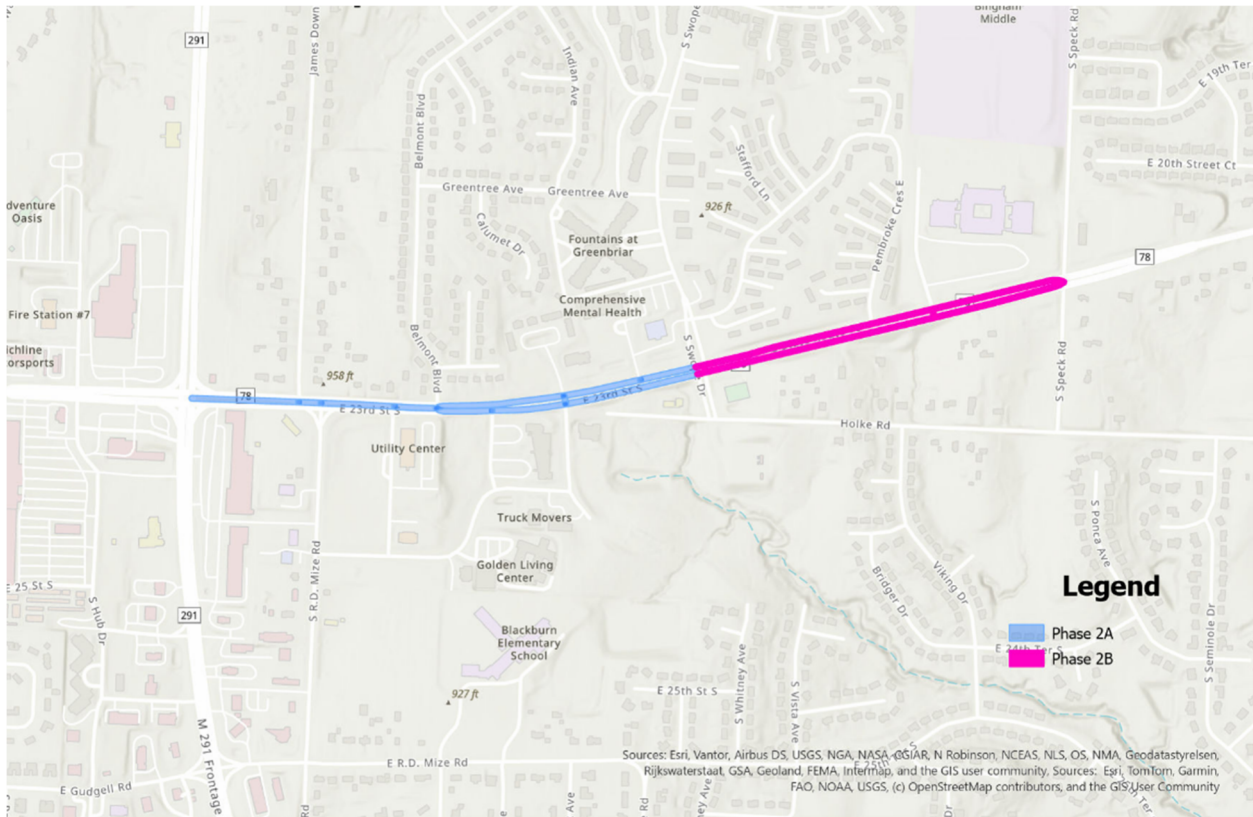

This letter serves as a formal request to amend Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) #(611210) and #(611209) for the Blue River Trail Martha Truman Segment 2 MoDOT TAP 3001(018) and Blue River Trail - Connector to MO Pacific Railroad Corridor project MoDOT TAP 3001(020). The amendment request is to combine the two listed TAP projects into one project with an amended scope. The trail segment described in TAP (018) was recently constructed under project TAP 3301 (519) Blue River Trail Connector Martha Truman Road.

Original Scope Description TAP 3001(018) BLUE RIVER TRAIL – MARTHA TRUMAN CONNECTOR SEGMENT 2: This project will extend the existing Blue River Trail in Minor Park south to Martha Truman Road by constructing segment 2 from the proposed pedestrian bridge to Martha Truman Road. The 10-foot wide, reinforced concrete trail will be located along the eastside of the Blue River and will provide users with a safe way to access park amenities.
