#### **Community Health Worker Initiative Grant Applications:**

**Authorize grant application to the Sunflower Foundation Kansas Fights Addiction program to support justice-involved community health worker training and workforce development.**

The Mid-America Regional Council Community Services Corporation (MARC CSC) has supported efforts to advance the Community Health Worker (CHW) workforce in Kansas and Missouri since 2016. This proposed program would enable MARC to build on the foundation established under KDHE's Beyond Walls: Community Health Worker (CHW) Certification Training During Incarceration initiative in Kansas jurisdictions.

**Authorize grant application to the Kansas Health Foundation Upward Mobility program to support justice-involved community health worker training and workforce development.**

The proposed program would enable MARC to build on the foundation established under KDHE's Beyond Walls: Community Health Worker (CHW) Certification Training During Incarceration initiative. The program is intended to build capacity within correctional facilities to deliver training, develop career paths and help justice-involved individuals gain marketable skills for meaningful employment that offers a livable wage upon reentry.

**Authorize grant application to the Health Forward Foundation to support CHW training and workforce development.**

The Health Forward Foundation has provided support to the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC) Community Services Corporation (CSC) for its work to convene the KC Regional CHW Collaborative, promote the CHW profession and encourage employment of CHWs, provide information and training on reimbursement of CHW services through Kansas Medicaid and Medicare, and integrate CHWs in diverse settings working collaboratively with other roles such as community paramedics in the community.
