Missouri Programming Committee Meeting Summary

July 2026

1. Welcome and Introductions

Missouri Programming Committee (MPC) Chair Sherri McIntyre welcomed members and guests and called the meeting to order. Attendance of this meeting is included at the end of this summary.

2. VOTE: April 14, 2026, Meeting Summary and May 12, 2026, Meeting Summary

The April meeting summary was not sent out in advance of the May meeting, so approval of that summary was deferred to the next meeting. The April meeting summary was later distributed by email to the committee.

Shelie Daniel moved to approve the April 14, 2026 and May 12, 2026 meeting summaries. Michael Park seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

3. VOTE: Missouri Program Status and Obligations Report

Transportation Program Manager Marc Hansen reviewed two requests received for changes to projects; a scope change request from the City of Independence for the 23rd Street (M-78) Sidewalks and Bicycle Improvements Project, and a request from Kansas City to combine the Blue River Trail Martha Truman Segment 2 and Blue River Trail - Connector to MO Pacific Railroad Corridor projects with an amended scope.

Committee members confirmed that multimodal elements will be retained in the Independence project, and that there will be no changes in design.

George Binger moved to approve the requested scope change to the Independence 23rd Street (M-78) Sidewalks and Bicycle Improvements Project, and Sabin Yanez seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Committee members confirmed the schedule for the combined Kansas City projects; the project would need a TIP amendment and updated RER approval so would likely slide into 2027, but so would have minimal impact to obligation targets. There is a cooperative agreement between Kansas City and Jackson County for the Blue River Greenway park lands.

Tawn Nugent moved to combine Kansas City projects Blue River Trail Martha Truman Segment 2 and Blue River Trail - Connector to MO Pacific Railroad Corridor as requested and move to the 2027 program. George Binger seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Marc Hansen reviewed existing projects by funding program, with project sponsors providing status updates.

The CMAQ program includes several projects eligible for FTA transfer, and has obligated roughly \$1.7 million, with remaining projects on track to obligate this year.

Three of the four projects on the Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) are making progress toward obligation this year, with the status of the Platte County - Route 152 Trail Completion project unknown at this time.

Marc Hansen reviewed projects on the STBG program that have not yet obligated. Harrisonville's M-2 Culvert over Muddy Creek project is expecting to have Right of Way (ROW) completed by end of September. Belton's Markey Parkway Phase 2 project will need a tribal request and conditional ROW. The status of Platte City's M-92 Capacity & Safety Improvements project is unknown. Gladstone's Downtown Gladstone North Oak Complete Street project is unlikely to make obligation this year. Riverside's Riverway Boulevard Improvements, Smithville's Bridge Street Roundabout, and Independence's Winner Road Complete Streets - US 24 to Hedges projects are all on track to obligate this year.

In the Transportation Alternatives (TA) program, Parkville's Bell Road Pedestrian Improvements project will not obligate in 2026. Kansas City's Paseo Boulevard Bikeways, Liberty's Liberty Drive Sidewalk/Trail Missing Link Connection, Grain Valley's Eagle Parkway (Rt. AA) Shared Trail, Kearney's Mack Porter Park Connector Shared-Use Path, Smithville projects Bridge Street Roundabout, Riverwalk Park - Phase 1, and Second Creek Sidewalk, and Independence's Fairmount Loop projects are all expected to meet obligation this year.

4. 2026 Suballocated Call for Projects Update

Marc Hansen informed the committee of the new deadline for the 2026 Suballocated Call for Projects, pushed one week to July 31. The rest of the timeline for the Call for Projects should not be affected. Next office hours will be available July 20 3-4pm, with a registration link on the application portal website. If you encounter any issues with the portal, please use the report a problem button within the portal.

5. Other Business

Summary details of applications received will be made available to the committee at the next meeting. The webpage for public comments is expected to be open by then as well.

The deadline for Functional Classification Changes was extended to July 17.

MARC's new executive director Geraldine Gardner will begin on October 1.
