Welcome and Introductions

Kansas Co-Chair Logan Heley called the meeting to order. Introductions in person and on Zoom followed.

Approval of May 2025 Meeting Summary

Kansas Co-Chair Logan Heley called for any additions or corrections to the meeting summary draft; no comments were made. Erin Ollig made a motion to approve the minutes with corrections, and Cathy Justice seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Planning Sustainable Places (PSP) Overview

Beth Dawson, PSP Program Manager with MARC, provided an overview of the history of the program, including its inception, history of projects funded, and goals of the program. Discussion followed on the different components that supported the redevelopment of the urban core, and the process for scoring and programming for the current call for projects. Beth explained the process that the committee will go through at their next two meetings to choose a funding scenario for projects funded in the 2027 Call for Projects.

MARC Public Participation Plan Overview

Cy Splichal, MARC, shared an overview of an update to MARC's Public Participation Plan. This plan creates guidelines for engaging the public in the transportation decision making and planning process. The committee discussed questions on their role in providing feedback and shaping the scope and outcomes of studies at MARC.
